	 That the pedestrian access to Dillons Road from St Michael Road and North End is poor and could prove a risk to vulnerable road users. 					
	 That the application was simply a precursor to a larger development that would result in many more properties being built on the site. 					
	 That the site was intended for agricultural purposes and not for housing development.
