Both AP and DG commented that he felt that there was a need to ensure that the majority of the funds were directed toward the village of Ham and it was agreed that this could be achieved via the workings of the Committee.						
	DG asked if there was a formal, legally-binding agreement in place with Innova to ensure that the funds would be paid. The Clerk and RFO confirmed that this was not in place at this time. DG offered to help draft a letter to Innova to secure this.

The Clerk and RFO confirmed that it would be retained for the remainder of this year and reviewed ahead of the 2025/26 budget.
